

Goal
Secure funding to hire dedicated trail
maintenance staff


The impact of powerful data

With the support of the Public Lands program, Maryland Forest Service:

Awarded a 3-year trail maintenance grant, to establish continuous funds with dedicated staff

Ensured efficient deployment of trail maintenance resources by monitoring AllTrails usage trends and heatmap data

3,800 maintenance hours logged on 100 miles of trails across three state forests



Update trail information and add alerts on AllTrails to help reduce negative user interactions with their trails.



Responsible trail stewardship

Grand County utilized the Public Lands program to curate the trail-goer experience.

118 alerts and 478 edits added, enhancing the quality of the trail information on AllTrails

Improved the safety of trail-goers and encouraged responsible recreation

Improve the quality of information on the Olympic National Park routes so visitors stay informed.


Real-time alerts to improve safety of visitors

Olympic National Park reached their audience with:

33 alerts and 219 edits implemented, strategically focusing on high-traffic areas

66% decrease in Search and Rescue (SAR)related incidents on trails with historically high SAR incidents

62% decrease in SAR-related incidents across routes on AllTrails
